Sechelt, BC – January 5, 2022 – Changes will be put in place for Transit services tonight and tomorrow morning on the Sunshine Coast due to an expected Winter storm and significant snowfall.

In addition, curbside waste collection and access to waste disposal facilities may also be affected.
