# **Lifeguard I and Instructor Guard Overview**

The Sunshine Coast Regional District (SCRD) is currently inviting applications for the temporary part-time position of Lifeguard I and Instructor Guard PHAFC (Pender Harbour Aquatic & Fitness Centre) to provide life-guarding services to the patrons of the Sunshine Coast Regional District, lead and instruct groups and individuals in swimming and fitness programs, act as senior shift lifeguard and perform janitorial and administrative duties. ### **Compensation and Benefits**

We have what is being called the very best compensation and benefit package that is out there. Immediately upon hire this position includes an additional \$3.05 per hour cash-in-lieu of benefits, offers 6% vacation pay, and after 30 days of employment the wage rate will include an additional 5% in lieu of statutory holiday pay. After 90 days of employment, casual employees are eligible for up to five (5) paid sick days for previously scheduled work.

This is a bargaining unit position with the following wage rates:

Lifeguard I \$27.23 per hour
Instructor Guard \$29.44 per hour

Working hours may vary but are expected to be about 25 hours per week with potential opportunities for additional hours. Schedules may include weekend and evening hours. Upon the return of the incumbent, this position will move from temporary part-time, to casual, and will have the opportunity to join the General Casual List. **Please note: This appointment is subject to a satisfactory RCMP Police Information Check.**
