**NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONTRACT**

The Sunshine Coast Regional District (Regional District) is hereby giving notice of its intent to direct award to Summit Valve and Controls a contract for the following service:

The following responsibilities will be within scope of contract:

The Contractor shall be responsible for the supply and delivery of the following components:

1. Two (2) Golden Harvest brand stop logs, complete with all required accessories for installation and operation.
2. Four (4) valves, also manufactured by Golden Harvest, suitable for integration with existing system infrastructure.

The total value of the contract will not exceed \$150,000.00. This contract will cover the period from August 10, 2025 to January 31, 2026, which includes lead time to receive stop logs and valves.

The Regional District has chosen not to tender this contract for the following reasons:

**1. Sole Authorized Supplier in BC**

Summit Valves is the sole authorized distributor and supplier of Golden Harvest valves and related components within BC. Given the project's specific requirement for Golden Harvest brand equipment to ensure compatibility with existing infrastructure.

**2. Specialized Project Knowledge**

Summit Valves possesses specialized and project-specific knowledge critical to the successful delivery of this scope. Their familiarity with the operational environment, technical requirements, and existing system configurations allows for more efficient coordination, reduced risk of error, and smoother integration of components. This expertise cannot be readily duplicated or acquired by another supplier without significant delays and additional cost.

**3. Urgent Operational Need**

The stop logs and valves are urgently required to support time-sensitive infrastructure work. Delaying procurement through a competitive process would

pose operational risks, potentially affecting service continuity, safety, and regulatory compliance.

Vendors wishing to object to this decision should contact the procurement services email [submissions@scrd.ca](mailto:submissions@scrd.ca) **on or before 3:00 p.m. local time on August 8, 2025 presenting specific reasons for their objections.** Vendor ability to offer the same level of service at a lower cost in the same time frame will be the key criteria with regard to the consideration of vendor objections.
