CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The Sunshine Coast Regional District is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Waugh Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 28, 2002.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is waterworks (local authority).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for waterworks purpose is 41,510 cubic meters a year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is all the lands within the boundaries of Egmont Cove within the Sunshine Coast Regional District.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe, pump station, water treatment facility, reservoir and distribution system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works (diversion structure and pipes from the pump station up to and including the distribution system) has been completed. The construction of the said works (water treatment facility, reservoir, pump station and pipe from the pump station to the intake pipe) shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2014. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of an Engineer under the Water Act, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream for the preservation of fish and other aquatic life.
- k) This Licence is issued in substitution of C116998, C116999, C117000, C117001, C117002, C117003, C117004, C117006, C117007, C117008, C117009, C117010, C117011, C117012, C117013, C117014, C117015, C117016, C117018, C117019, C117020, C117022, C117045, and C117791.

PERMIT AUTHORIZING THE OCCUPATION OF CROWN LAND

The holder of the following Water Licences, whose licence authorizes the diversion and use of water from Waugh Lake, is hereby authorized to occupy Crown land by constructing, maintaining and operating thereon the works authorized under the said licences.

Water Licence No(s): C127866

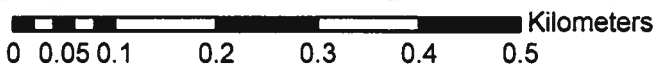
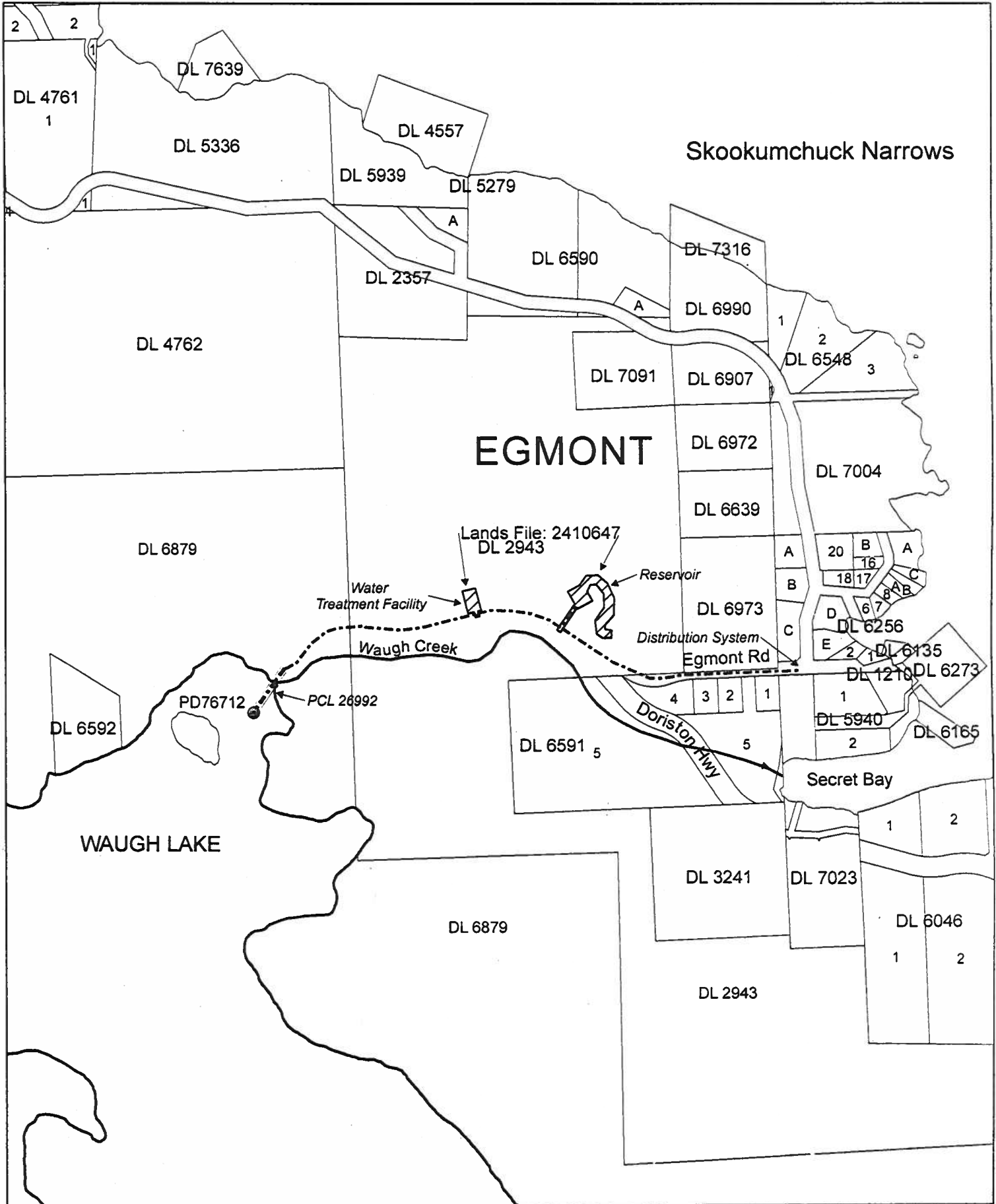
- (a) The Crown land which is authorized to be occupied under this permit is a portion of unsurveyed foreshore or land covered by water being part of the bed of Waugh Lake, together with that parcel or tract of land in the vicinity of District Lot 2943, Group 1, New Westminster District, the location of which is shown approximately on the plan attached to the said water licence.
- (b) The approximate dimensions of the Crown land authorized to be occupied under this permit are for: Works 76 metres (250 feet) in length by 4.6 metres (15 feet) in width, having an area of 0.03496 hectare.
- (c) Prior to cutting, destroying or clearing of any timber necessary to construct, maintain and operate the said works or the clearing of the said lands which may be flooded, the permittee shall apply for and obtain a licence to cut timber from the Ministry of Forests, District Manager. The amount of stumpage, royalty and/or compensation payable to the Crown in respect of trees, including merchantable or young growth, cut, removed, damaged, or destroyed by the permittee, shall be the sum or sums fixed by the Forest Service of the Province of British Columbia.
- (d) This permit is appurtenant to the land, mine, or undertaking to which the aforesaid water licence is appurtenant.
- (e) This permit shall become void if the water licence with respect to which the permit is issued should terminate, be abandoned or cancelled, or amended so as to render this permit unnecessary.
- (f) This permit is issued and accepted on the understanding that the permittee shall indemnify and save harmless the Government of the Province of British Columbia for all loss, damage to works, cost or expense suffered by the permittee by reason of the Crown land or any portion thereof being submerged or damaged by erosion.
- (g) The holder of this permit shall not be entitled to compensation if the Crown grants permits to other persons to occupy the land affected by this permit.
- (h) In the event of a dispute at any time with respect to the area or boundaries of the land affected by this permit, the holder shall, at his own expense, have the said land surveyed by a duly authorized surveyor.
- (i) This permit replace Permit Numbers: 24105, 24106, 24107, 24108, 24109, 24110, 24111, 24113, 24114, 24115, 24116, 24117, 24118, 24119, 24120, 24121, 24140, 24141, 24144, 24145, 24146, 24147, 24148, and 24481.
