“.6 Owner’s Representative will review the Contractor’s site specific Safety Plan and provide comments to the Contractor within ten [10] days after receipt of the plan. Revised plan as appropriate and resubmit plan to Owner’s representative withing five [5] days after receipt of comments from the Owner’s Representative.

Add / Replace with:

“.6 The Contractor is solely responsible for all site safety, including the development, implementation, and enforcement of its Site-specific Safety Plan, and for compliance with all applicable health and safety laws. The Owner’s Representative’s role is limited to reviewing the Contractor’s submitted Specific Safety Plan, and for compliance with all applicable health and safety laws. The Owner’s Representative’s role is limited to reviewing the Contractor’s submitted-Specific Safety Plan, and for compliance with all applicable health and safety laws. The Owner’s Representative’s role is limited to reviewing the Contractor’s submitted Safety Plan for general conformance with the Contract requirements.

Within ten [10] days of receiving the Contractor’s Site-specific S-Specific Safety Plan, the Owner’s Representative may provide comments. Any comments or lack of comments shall not be construed as approval of the plan, nor shall they relieve the Contractor of its sole responsibility for site safety.

The Contractor shall revise the Safety Plan as appropriate and resubmit it within five [5] days of receiving the Owner’s Representative’s comments. The Contractor remains fully responsible for the adequacy, completeness, and implementation of the Safety Plan, regardless of any review, comment, or request for revision by the Owner or its Representative.”

Amendment No.1 is issued prior to receipt of submission and shall form part of the contract documents. The revisions shall clarify the information contained in the original Proposal documents issued on February 11, 2026.
