Position Overview

The Sunshine Coast Regional District is currently inviting applications for the full-time position of Capital Projects Engineer. We are currently looking for a friendly and talented person to join our team! Reporting to the Manager, Capital Projects, this position provides technical leadership, coordination and expertise to divisional staff and contractors in the performance of a range of engineering design, project management work and activities. There is every expectation that assignments with higher-rated responsibilities will arise that will attract additional compensation, and this can be discussed further at an interview.

Compensation and Hours of Work

This is a bargaining unit position with a wage rate of \$46.24 per hour, working 35 hours per week. Annual vacation starts at 4%, increasing to 6% after a four-month probationary period, and includes 13 paid statutory holidays (after 30 days of employment). After passing probation, you will then receive a full benefit package that includes extended health and dental coverage, paid sick leave, family responsibility leave, eyewear, eye exams, group life insurance, short-term and long-term disability benefits, participation in the Municipal Pension Plan (MPP), accidental death and dismemberment coverage. And finally, all SCRD employees have access to the Employee and Family Assistance Program (EFAP) upon hire, for free, confidential counselling services.
