Position Overview

The Sunshine Coast Regional District is currently inviting applications for the temporary full-time position of Planning Technician I or II. We are currently looking for a friendly and experienced person to join our team. Under the general direction of the Manager, Planning and Development, the Planning Technician II provides technical support to the SCRD development control processes for the Planning and Development Division. Please note that the SCRD may consider filling this vacancy as a Planning Technician I, for someone willing to obtain the necessary certification to become qualified as a Planning Technician II, within a reasonable amount of time.

Compensation and Hours of Work

This is a bargaining unit position working up to 35 hours per week with the following wage rates:

Planning Technician I \$33.79Planning Technician II \$38.02

This position offers 4% vacation pay and 5% statutory holiday pay (after 30 days of employment). Upon successful completion of a four-month probationary period with the SCRD, this position will then expand to include 6% vacation pay and an additional \$3.05 per hour cash-in-lieu of benefits. Please note that current regular employees of the SCRD who post into temporary vacancies will retain, or receive, full benefit coverage.
